Pickup, entry, and records a director can stand behind

Small campuses without a district RFP — intercom at the door, cameras for staff, coverage on the lot.



The problem

A shared keypad code is not access control. A consumer camera in the lobby is not a pickup plan. Private schools and daycares are small, but the liability and the parent conversation are not.

After hours, the same property is a building with a lot and a playground. Trespass and vandalism show up in the morning. Staff should not spend an afternoon scrubbing footage to find one clip.

Intercom at pickup

A call box at the secured entry, answering stations inside — office and classroom wing — so staff see who is at the door without leaving the room.

Entry records

Readers and locks on the doors that actually matter, with an audit trail. Shared codes go away.

Cameras for the operator

Entries, hallways, lots, and playgrounds. Identity analytics only where policy allows — written down before they go on the drawing.

Past the office

Staff parking, fields, and buildings cable never reached — a designed hop off the main building when the shot is there.
